

## **COMMENTS**

A Raving Beauty 3-5 record in US including two Grade 1 wins over 1m; could cope with this test

Athena Won 1m2f 3yo Grade 1 Belmont Oaks (firm) in July but found things tougher since

Eziyra Five 7f-1m4f Group 2/3 wins in Ireland including at the Curragh latest; goes on any ground

Fourstar Crook Better than ever 2018 - two G2 wins, twice 2nd to Sistercharlie in G1s, won 1m2f Grade 1

Fuhriously Kissed Ordinary dirt horse; unplaced in three turf runs; now up to furthest trip; look elsewhere

Magic Wand Runner-up in French Group 1s last two starts, most recently 1l behind Wild Illusion

Mom's On Strike Has won here on slow turf and stays well, but doesn't look good enough; blinkers refitted

Paved Improved second in 1m2f Grade 1 Rodeo Drive at Santa Anita latest; this is much tougher

Princess Yaiza Irish trained; improved to win 12.5f French Group 2 latest, but loads more needed

Santa Monica Landed Woodbine G2 in June, but only third in a weak running of G1 EP Taylor there latest

Sistercharlie Second in last year's French Oaks and three-time Grade 1 winner in US; furthest trip yet

Smart Choice Won Group 1 in Peru in June; this looks too big an ask on US debut

Thais Front-running third behind two of these when upped to 9.5f in G1 Beverly D at Arlington

Wild Illusion Dual G1 winner in France, most recently the Prix de l'Opera; connections won this last yr
