VERDICT

Having lost an unbeaten record in his trial over 7f on soft going, MADHMOON (nap) can sparkle again under today's different conditions.

COMMENTS

Advertise A leading 2yo, 2nd in 7f Dewhurst here, but on pedigree he is not sure to get 1m

Al Hilalee 2-2 last summer; plenty of potential, even if his form cannot compare with many of these

Azano Unable to land a blow behind Shine So Bright when fav for Free Handicap (7f, good to firm)

Dark Vision Too early to forget that he looked an exciting prospect in 7f Group 2 at Goodwood as 2yo

Emaraaty Ana Easily his best was front-running win in Group 2 at York (6f) in August; bred to stay

Great Scot Work to do but he's proved himself at 1m and a strong pace would help him to settle

Kick On 2 front-running wins, including by neck in 1m1f Listed race here (good to firm) on return

King Of Change Won novice at Nottingham (1m, good to firm) on return; Guineas is a world away from that

Madhmoon Beaten at 7f on soft on return but looked very good with 1m wins on sound surface as 2yo

Magna Grecia Gave French star Persian King a fright over C&D; then narrowly won 1m Doncaster Group 1

Momkin 28-1, neck 2nd to Skardu in C&D Craven (good to firm) and didn't get the ideal run through

Name The Wind Two tight wins on Kempton AW; has a bright future but this race is asking a lot

Royal Marine Won 1m Group 1 at Longchamp as 2yo; only fourth in the C&D Craven last time

Set Piece Still looked a good prospect when 2l third in the Craven over C&D; now has tongue tied

Shine So Bright Improved to dominate the 7f Free Handicap here on reappearance; not crying out for 1m

Skardu 2-2, both at this track; on return he beat three of these in the 1m Craven; potential

Sporting Chance Does not look good enough; after 11 starts, he should be hugely more exposed than most

Ten Sovereigns 6f hat-trick culminated in Group 1 Middle Park here; stamina question but the best form

Urban Icon 3l third of eight, passed by Great Scot, in the Greenham; plenty to find but promising
