Battaash has shown his best form elsewhere but the reverse is true for BLUE POINT who came home like a train to win this in 2018.

## COMMENTS

- Battaash Strong form claims on his best efforts but outstayed by Blue Point in this race last year
- Blue Point Course specialist who saw out this stiff 5f better than Battaash in this race last June
- Enzo's Lad Won two Group 1s at 6f in New Zealand; races mostly at that trip now; in very deep here
- Equilateral Weights favoured him when close 2nd to Mabs Cross in Group 3 in May; needs plenty more
- Fairyland Group 1 winner over 6f at 2; non-stayer in 1m Classics this year; having first 5f run
- Houtzen Multiple Australian winner; yet to win above Group 3 level; further improvement needed
- Imprimis Improving 5yo who handles any ground; smart 5f win in April; F Dettori up; interesting
- Judicial Group 3 winner last summer; below best on reappearance; up against it at the top level
- Mabs Cross Staying-on 3rd in this last year; since won French Group 1; well held by Battaash latest
- Sergei Prokofiev Looked very promising at 5f when won Group 3 in Oct; low-key latest; still has potential
- Signora Cabello Dual 5f Group winner at 2; low key at 6f in 2019; return to 5f can suit but up against it
- Soldier's Call Close 3rd to Mabs Cross in the Abbaye; needs to have progressed from 2 to 3 to figure
