Houtzen Multiple Australian winner; yet to win above Group 3 level; further improvement needed Imprimis Improving 5yo who handles any ground; smart 5f win in April; F Dettori up; interesting

Judicial Group 3 winner last summer; below best on reappearance; up against it at the top level

Mabs Cross Staying-on 3rd in this last year; since won French Group 1; well held by Battaash latest

Sergei Prokofiev Looked very promising at 5f when won Group 3 in Oct; low-key latest; still has potential

Signora Cabello Dual 5f Group winner at 2; low key at 6f in 2019; return to 5f can suit but up against it Soldier's Call Close 3rd to Mabs Cross in the Abbaye; needs to have progressed from 2 to 3 to figure
