An open-looking renewal in which LAURENS is taken to reverse Lockinge placings with Mustashry. Several others can be respected.

## COMMENTS



Accidental Agent 33-1 winner of this race last year; creditable third in the Lockinge on reappearance

Barney Roy Only Listed form since returning to racing but he was a G1 winner at this meeting in 2017

Beat The Bank Four-time winner at Group 2 level but has form figures of 0065000 in Group 1 races

Dream Castle Meydan hat-trick earlier in year; not disgraced in French Group 1 last time

Hazapour Group 3 winner back over 1m last time; now 2-2 at this trip and looks interesting

Laurens Admirable filly who won four G1 races in 2018; creditable second in the Lockinge on return

Le Brivido Won the Jersey here in 2017 for Andre Fabre; promising run in the Lockinge last month

Lord Glitters Close second in this contest 12 months ago; well beaten in the Lockinge last time

Matterhorn Highly progressive on AW; useful turf form the last twice but this is much harder

Mustashry Has got better with age; Lockinge win from Laurens sets him up perfectly for this

Mythical Magic Group 2 winner at Meydan; ran the worst race of his career in the Lockinge next time

Olmedo Smart French miler who won last year's Poulains; neck second in Group 2 latest outing

One Master Foret winner; needs a career best in this field and stiff 1m may not be the ideal scenario

Romanised Won last year's Irish 2,000 Guineas; best effort since when fourth in the Lockinge

Sharja Bridge Listed winner on reappearance then ran well in Group 2; form dipped in the Lockinge

Stormy Antarctic Two wins on the continent this term; hasn't scored on home soil since 2016
