Maqsad Impressive 1m2f Listed winner in May; failed to stay 1m4f in Oaks; could have major say

Mehdaayih Others have more substance to their form but we may not yet have seen the best of her

Nyaleti Listed winner here last season but exposed and has something to find today

Rawdaa Went close in Group 2s last twice; there could be more to come from this lightly raced 4yo

Sun Maiden Listed/Group 3 wins the last twice but has a much tougher task today
