A chance is taken on Japanese challenger DEIRDRE. Soft ground may not have suited at Royal Ascot and the long straight is in her favour.

### COMMENTS

Channel Won Group 1 Prix de Diane; not taken on lightly but the form is perhaps not overly strong Deirdre Interesting Japanese challenger who may not have been suited by soft ground at Royal Ascot Hermosa Dual Guineas winner this May; time looks right for step up to 1m2f; leading claims Just Wonderful Creditable US Grade 1 run on first crack at 1m2f last time out; no forlorn hope Maqsad Impressive 1m2f Listed winner in May; failed to stay 1m4f in Oaks; could have major say Mehdaayih Others have more substance to their form but we may not yet have seen the best of her Nyaleti Listed winner here last season but exposed and has something to find today Rawdaa Went close in Group 2s last twice; there could be more to come from this lightly raced 4yo Sun Maiden Listed/Group 3 wins the last twice but has a much tougher task today
