VERDICT

Preference is for **AL BOUM PHOTO (nap)** who sets the standard on the form of his win in this race last year and has had an identical prep.

COMMENTS

Al Boum Photo Won this last year; same preparation as last season, winning at Tramore; good chance

Bristol De Mai Each-way shout on last year's 3rd but there's a slight stamina concern on soft ground

Chris's Dream Each-way chance on his good recent form, with ground and trip likely to suit

Clan Des Obeaux Top-class form when winning his second King George latest; big stamina worry

Delta Work Strong stayer at 3m and he is a 7yo on the upgrade, so could well find the bit more needed

Elegant Escape Smart performer but even his best form will need improving upon if he's to be placed today

Kemboy Big form chance on last spring's two Grade 1 wins; needs to jump a bit better

Lostintranslation Disappointing in the King George latest at Christmas; progressing really well previously

Monalee Very smart but a bit more is needed and he wouldn't be a certain stayer

Presenting Percy Dual Festival winner; seems safely held by Delta Work on this season's Leopardstown form

Real Steel Needs a significant career best and has been well held in two previous Festival runs

Santini Latest Grade 2 win here in January, when outstaying Bristol De Mai, was much more like it
