**BETTING FORECAST** 11/4 Solo, 3/1 Goshen, 4/1 Allmankind, 6/1 Aspire Tower, 11/1 Sir Psycho, 12/1 A Wave Of The Sea, 16/1 Burning Victory, Cerberus, 25/1 Navajo Pass, 33/1 Hook Up, 40/1 Lord Lamington, 66/1 Never Do Nothing, Yellow Tiger.**VERDICT** Preference is for **SOLO** who was highly impressive in the Grade 2 Adonis at Kempton last month on his first run for Paul Nicholls.**COMMENTS** **A Wave Of The Sea** The hill and strong gallop should suit but Leopardstown Grade 1 win was probably fortunate**Allmankind** Headstrong front-runner but he's 3-3 over hurdles and impressed in Chepstow Grade 1 latest**Aspire Tower** Form of Grade 2 win reads well but had a battle on his hands when faller in Grade 1 latest**Burning Victory** Won Fairyhouse Grade 3 on hurdle debut; lots of potential but inexperience is a concern**Cerberus** Has some good Irish form but was put in his place by Allmankind at Chepstow in December**Goshen** Bundles to spare on first three hurdle starts and has the form to be a major player**Hook Up** Promising third on hurdle debut but she'd be a surprise winner of this much hotter race**Lord Lamington** Solid efforts on first three hurdle starts but lots of improvement is needed here**Navajo Pass** The demands of Cheltenham could bring out the best in him but others have stronger form**Never Do Nothing** Impressed on hurdle/stable debut at Musselburgh but then well beaten in Irish Grade 1**Sir Psycho** Tougher test today but has won in fine style the last twice and he's not ruled out**Solo** Skipped clear in Kempton Grade 2 on British/stable debut and he's an exciting prospect**Yellow Tiger** Had to work hard on recent hurdle debut at Market Rasen; will be a shock if he follows up
