

CORNICHE established command into the first turn, angled in to dictate terms, dug in to meet the challenge entering the stretch and gamely held sway. PAPPACAP checked off heels into the first turn, settled into stride along the inside within striking distance, got through to make his bid, shifted out a bit but

was unable to bridge the gap. GIANT GAME settled in hand, ranged up four wide through the second turn, loomed large entering the stretch, but lacked the needed late response. COMMANDPERFORMANCE stalked the pace three deep, was in striking distance to the final furlong, but weakened between rivals in the drive. OVIATT CLASS was unhurried along the inside, checked in tight leaving the seven-sixteenths pole, altered to the outside, looped into the lane seven wide and was making up ground. PINEHURST chased off of the inside, continued on between runners through the second turn to the stretch and weakened. AMERICAN SANCTUARY came away a step slow, was unhurried into stride, finished with a belated improvement but failed to threaten. DOUBLE THUNDER settled well back, moved up four wide on the second turn, but failed to sustain the drive. BAROSSA was restless in the gate, came away in good order, settled off of the pace, but lacked a response when called upon. JASPER GREAT broke a step slow, and saved ground to no avail. TOUGH TO TAME was never a factor.
