MARCHE LORRAINE (JPN) settled in the two path or outside rival, went three deep into the far turn, bid five wide between then cleared into the stretch, led through the lane and just held over the runner-up. DUNBAR ROAD reserved in the early going, lacked room and got shuffled into the far turn, steered out around the bend, bumped with rival in upper stretch then again at the eighth pole, closed gamely inside the winner and missed. MALATHAATH unhurried and moved inside, took closer order up the backstretch, angled out and put to a drive on the far turn, bumped in upper stretch then again at the eighth pole, finished willingly and held the show. CLAIRIERE lagged behind early, trailed to the far turn, ranged up wide on the second bend, got floated seven wide into the stretch, rallied and missed the show. ROYAL FLAG raced near the back early on, moved out in the middle stages, made a swift move six wide on the final turn, drifted into the stretch and got outkicked in the furlong grounds. SHEDARESTHEDEVIL off alertly and traveled three deep early, chased the leader four wide around the clubhouse turn, bid four deep into the second bend, led briefly past the five-sixteenths pole, relinquished command around the bend and weakened in the stretch run. BLUE STRIPE (ARG) got shuffled shortly after the start, angled to the inside, steered off the rail backstretch, moved closer outside a rival, went three wide into the far turn, five wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. AS TIME GOES BY chased in the two path then moved inside, saved ground to the stretch and faded. HOROLOGIST angled in and tracked from inside, moved off the rail in the middle stages, got shuffled

and steadied at the three-eighths pole, exited the turn two wide and could not rally. LETRUSKA raced between early then chased three wide around the turn, applied pressure on the backstretch, took a short lead past the three-eighths pole, lost command with five-sixteenth remaining and faded out of contention. PRIVATE MISSION sped clear from inside, showed the way with company alongside on the backstretch, lost the lead past the three-eighths pole, dropped back around the turn, angled four wide and had little left for the stretch.
